 - a. The Glory of God's Person
 - glory radiant essence, majestic aura, glorious presence
describing one repute, extolling
 - b. The Glorification of God
 - 2. He is Awesome (1:25b₃)
 - majesty loftiness, exceedingly high
 - 3. He is Invincible (1:25b₄)
 - dominion overwhelming power, strength
victory, supremacy, rulership
 - 4. He is Sovereign (1:25b₅₋₆)
 - authority delegated power, ability to act
